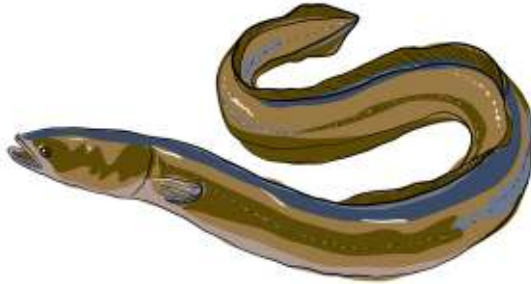


Endangered Culture European Eel



The European eel has an extraordinary migratory journey that takes it from the Sargasso Sea near Bermuda across the Atlantic Ocean to Europe and then back again.

However the number of eels arriving in Europe has fallen by 95% in the last 40 years.

This has been due to factors such as habitat loss and degradation, the construction of dams, reduced water quality, overfishing, disease, all of which are further exacerbated by climate change.
