

Endangered Culture Little Plumpton



Little Plumpton in Lancashire is one of the only two fracking sites in England. Fracking was suspended at the site due to earthquakes in 2019, however this is not a permanent shut down.

Large swathes of the country are covered by fracking licenses, entitling the extraction of oil and gas by fossil fuel companies. The recent lifting of the fracking ban puts other important natural areas such as the South Downs and North York Moors at risk, as well as increased social and health risks to communities all across England.
