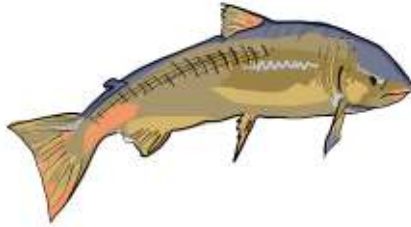


Endangered Culture Wild Atlantic Salmon



Known as the 'king of fish', wild Atlantic salmon have significantly declined in British rivers with less than 5% of salmon that leave Britain's rivers returning - a decline of nearly 70% in 25 years.

Dangers to salmon include drift netting, water abstraction, agricultural runoff, intensive farming and salmon farms.

They are also extremely sensitive to water temperature changes caused by climate change, as well as increased sea-lice contamination.
