LAUNCHING THE GLOBAL CALL



Led by the Climate Heritage Network, the Global Call first launched in 2023 to urge policy-makers to put culture, heritage, and creativity at the heart of climate action. Thanks to your signatures, advocacy and partnership, the call successfully united over 1000 networks and organisations calling for ambitious policy outcomes.

Now, building on this momentum, the movement evolves as **We Make Tomorrow**, with the same commitment to unite artists, activists, designers, and heritage keepers in climate action, and **to make culture a pillar of global climate policy**.

With the 1.5º limit on warming looking increasingly out of reach, it's more urgent than ever to put culture at the heart of transformative climate action. Around the world culture and heritage remain resolute - together we can make a different tomorrow.

WE MAKE TOMORROW

Kicking off Africa Climate Week in Addis Ababa, Marcele Oliveira - COP 30 Youth Champion and We Make Tomorrow Ambassador - launched the second stage of the Global Call to place culture at the heart of climate action.

Almost 2,000 individuals, 560+ organisations and 115+ networks have already signed the Global Call, representing more than 200,000 voices across 100+ countries.


WHY IS POLICY OUR COP 30 GOAL?

Creative and cultural responses to climate, nature and justice restoration are thriving worldwide. But this work is fragmented and lacks recognition, especially within policy-informed decision-making.

Why this matters: Policy recognises, protects, and strengthens people and planet. Culture needs the validation, frameworks, and resources that will turn creative momentum into lasting systems change. We Make Tomorrow is seeking culture-led policy to protect, connect and transform how people think, feel and act on climate. But the movement needs strengthening.

Embedding culture into climate policy - Global Stocktake 2, Nationally Determined Contributions, National Adaptation Plans - ensures that cultural rights, indigenous and community knowledge systems, culture, and creativity are empowered to be at the centre of just and equitable transition pathways to 1.5 degrees limit on warming.

With the support of policy, culture can **inspire**, **connect**, **and transform action on climate**.





YOUR SUPPORT IS NEEDED

So far we have successfully secured **85k GBP** in funding as well as further in-kind support valued at over **100k GBP**. To reach our goals we are seeking **interim emergency funding of 35k GBP**.

Additional resourcing is **urgently needed** to sustain our work in the lead-up to COP30 - supporting on-the-ground delivery in Belém.

We are very excited to share that in partnership with the COP30 Presidency, and Youth Climate Champion Marcele Oliveira, we have the opportunity to host an Intergenerational Cocktail Event in support of the We Make Tomorrow campaign, focused on the youth involved in the Global Call and their work supporting culture and Climate.

- Mutual aid and stipends for Artists, Creatives Belem and Amazonia voices.




LOOKING AHEAD TO COP31 AMPLIFYING IMPACT

To amplify the impact of **We Make Tomorrow** we are seeking continued resourcing to scale our efforts in the following areas:

- **Sponsor a Regional Hub:** We are seeking 60k GBP per hub, to kickstart the full development and local implementation of the campaign in x5 locations.
- Support a Champion: We are seeking 2k GBP per champion to support the travel, subsistence and stipends for x10 young WMT ambassadors.
